

Directions: From Girard Avenue, turn North onto 3rd Street. Turn right at the first stop sign. Turn Left at American Street. Crane Arts will be the large wedge-shaped building located one block North at the corner of Master and American Streets.

By Subway: Take the Market-Frankford line to the Girard Avenue exit. Walk 6 blocks West on Girard Ave. Turn Right on 2nd Street and walk 2 blocks North. Turn left on Master and walk 2 blocks West to American Street. The Crane Arts building will be ahead and to your right (there is signage at the very top of the building).
